Flying Fields, which is situated in the beautiful market town of Southam has proven to be a success with prospective homebuyers, as over 50% of the 535 homes available have already been sold.

A development of 2, 3, 4 and 5 bedroom homes, Flying Fields offers views across the south Warwickshire countryside and is ideal for everyone, from first time buyers, young professionals and growing families. The creation of a new community is at the heart of the development with a new multi-use games area, plenty of green open space, public art and a community hall due to be open in 2021.

Plots are spread across four character areas including the Rural Edge, where homes overlook public open space and Napton-on-the-Hill, as well as the Spine Road Mews areas.

Southam has a wealth of amenities including a post office and pharmacy, along with a wide choice of cafes and pubs. There are also excellent commuter links by road and rail, with Leamington Spa railway station just a short distance from Flying Fields offering trains to Birmingham and London.

New health and safety measures in place at Flying Fields

Our Flying Fields development recently reopened its doors following a temporary closure to help prevent the spread of Covid-19. Since reopening we have introduced new working guidelines for all of our sales offices and showhomes to protect the health and safety of our customers and employees. These include the installation of Perspex screens and marker guides for social distancing. All visits to our development are by appointment only and show home viewings will be unaccompanied with only one family at a time able to view each home.

through the development name and now the addition of a statue, which matches the logo of the development and is designed to mark the history of the site as an RAF training base. The commemorative model of an aeroplane was unveiled during a special service on Remembrance Day 2019.

Flt Lt Daryll Moreton, Officer Commanding 2028 Southam Squadron Royal Air Force Air Cadets, said: "It was a privilege to witness the unveiling of the new statue at the Flying Fields development. It marked a poignant moment in the history of the site and reminds us of the important role played by the service people who were stationed at RAF Southam during the Second World War."

Both first time buyers and existing homeowners can use the Government backed Help to Buy: Equity Loan scheme to secure selected homes with a deposit as low as 5%. Alternatively, existing homeowners can benefit from our Part Exchange or Easymover schemes, through which we can help customers move on from their current homes.

Customers can also benefit from the Stamp Duty holiday, saving thousands of pounds on the cost of moving. Anyone buying a home below £500,000 in England will be exempt from paying Stamp Duty until April 2021, giving buyers an extra boost towards stepping onto or up the property ladder or downsizing from their current home.

The Home Reach scheme is also available at Flying Fields, where a customer can buy a share of their chosen home and pay a low monthly rent on the part that isn't bought. With our partnership, a customer can initially purchase up to 75% of the chosen home and HEYLO will become the landlord, granting a 125-year lease.
